Judge Hess spoke to Carlisle Exchange about Juvenile Delinquency and the Law

At our meeting on March 22nd, our speaker was the Honorable Kevin A. Hess. Judge Hess recently retired after 30 years of working for the Court of Common Pleas of Cumberland County.

During his presentation he covered his educational background and then discussed how the laws in Pennsylvania apply to juveniles.

He explained that it is important to keep juveniles in a separate court system from adults whenever possible. He also feels that while some cases result in an Adjudication of Delinquency, a much better solution is for the case to be sent before a Youth Aid Panel. The Youth Aid Panel program is a diversionary program for first-time juvenile offenders who admit guilt. It allows juveniles, their parents, and volunteer panel members to work together to find a resolution to the offense. He ended his presentation and took questions from the members is attendance.
