Youth of the Year Award Process

The Youth of the Year (YOTY) Award recognizes hard-working high school students who attain high levels of scholastic achievement, community involvement and leadership and plan to attend college. Each year students from Big Spring, Boiling Springs and Carlisle High Schools apply.

In addition to their GPA, the application requires students to list their participation in school activities such as student government, school newspaper, band, orchestra, choir, debate team, stage performances, athletic teams, and clubs. The community service activities section includes their membership in community organizations and volunteer service hours for each semester. After listing all their special achievements and awards, they include a paragraph describing their most outstanding achievement. Finally, the applicant includes an essay on a theme selected by The National Exchange Club. This year's national theme is "I recognize my responsibility in shaping America's future. I have stepped out of my comfort zone during uncertain times and made a difference. I am part of history and here is where it started."

Normally, the club's YOTY committee selects one student from each of the three schools to recognize with a certificate and check at our club's first meeting in April. The committee also selects one of the three students to move onto the District Competition with a possibility of competing at the National level.

Accepting the Challenge of Excellence Award

The Accepting the Challenge of Excellence (A.C.E.) Award recognizes high school students who have had to overcome great physical, emotional, or social obstacles and are now eligible for high school graduation. A partial list of difficulties to overcome include physical, language, child abuse, delinquency, and/or substance abuse. These students either go onto college or other educational endeavors. Each year students from Big Spring, Boiling Springs and Carlisle High Schools apply.

This application does not include any information about a student's grades or involvement in school activities. Instead, a school guidance counselor describes the obstacle the student had to overcome, how the student overcame that obstacle, and any implications for the future. The applicant writes two brief narratives on the subjects of "the event in your life of which you are most proud" and "your future plans for making your community, and the world, a better place to live."

Normally, the club's A.C.E. committee selects one student from each of the three schools to recognize with a certificate and check at our club's second meeting in April. The committee also selects one of the three students to move onto the the District Competition with a possibility of competing at the National level. Remember that Keisha Ickes from Big Spring High School won the 2014 National A.C.E Award.




March 9 - All Member Zoom Meeting
