Alternatively, if you are able, *please consider a multi-year pledge*. This will allow us to properly plan for the scholarships in the years to come. We are also considering an increase in the award amount to better keep up with the rising costs of post-secondary education.

We currently have five members who have pledged \$100 per year for the next three years. With our scholarship costs at \$ 3,000/year plus expenses for the award winners at the Convention, we are operating at a shortfall. We would love to move this pledge commitment to every club in the district as well as individual commitments from another 15 Exchangites. *Your help is needed!*

Each year your local Exchange Clubs submit club award winners to the district level for a chance to receive a \$1,500 Youth scholarship and a \$1,500 ACE scholarship. District winners are then eligible to compete for the National Youth and A.C.E. scholarships of \$15,000 apiece. What a great opportunity for our high school seniors!!
