March 9 - All Member Zoom Meeting





The candidates must include their narrative under 500 words describing the event (or events) in their life of which they are most proud. This narrative must also describe their future plans for making your community, and the world, a better place to live, and a paragraph about their perspective of what their veteran or first responder parent/grandparent have done. A second narrative; not to exceed 500 words, from a parent, grandparent, school official, or exchange club member is to describe why they feel the candidate should earn the Legacy of the Year Award including implications for the candidate's future.
