## **New Member Process**

Once you find a potential new member, do you know what the process is for them to become a member? Any member may invite a potential new member to a meeting. The club will pay for one meal for the guest to attend a meeting to decide if they would like to become a member. Please let Secretary John Murray know you are bringing a prospective new member to a meeting.

The prospective new member will provide all the information needed on the attached card to Secretary John Murray. If accepted by the Board, the potential new member will pay the registration fee of \$35.00. However, the dues of about \$110 for the first year will be paid by the club. Then, the potential new member will be inducted as soon as possible and will become a full member.

## **HELP: National Blood Crisis**

The Red Cross is experiencing the worst blood shortage in over a decade. The dangerously low blood supply levels have forced some hospitals to defer patients from major surgery including organ transplants.

The Carlisle Sertoma Club (311 E. North Street Carlisle, PA 17013), a service club also helping Carlisle, is hosting a Red Cross Blood Drive on March 25, 2022, from 12:00 – 6:00 in memory of one of their members, Ken Wise. They asked our club to help them with this project. This is by appointment only which can be made online at Schedule Your Blood Donation with The Red Cross (redcrossblood.org) or by calling 1-800-RED CROSS. There are appointments available for whole blood (all blood types) and Power Blood (type A Neg, B Neg, or O blood). Whole blood is frequently given to trauma patients and people undergoing surgery. Red cells from Power Red donations are typically given to trauma patients, newborns and emergency transfusions during birth, people with sickle cell anemia, and anyone suffering blood loss.

Donors previously deferred for risk due to time spent in low-risk European countries, time spent on U.S. military bases in Europe or for use of bovine insulin, may now be eligible to give if they meet all other eligibility requirements.

## **Change to Meeting Time**

On May 10 & June 14, the second Tuesday of the month meetings will be Lunchtime meetings at 12:30 - 2:00 at Miseno's II Ristro Pub. This came about because the evening slot was not available and some members have stated they are uncomfortable driving at night, but would like to still attend.
