Blue Pinwheel Garden Fundraiser

Last year we sold 602 pinwheels. Our goal this year is 800. The Community Garden will

be set up the whole month of April in front of St. John's Episcopal Church and First Presbyterian Church on the Square. On Monday, April 1, club volunteers will be planting the pinwheels sold by the end of March and will plant additional pinwheels as more people purchase them for a donation of \$5 each. The money raised will go to Domestic Violence Services of Cumberland and Perry Counties' children's programs. There is a donor page listing the names of the individuals who donate or elect to designate a pinwheel in honor of a child or other person. A separate page will list any business or organization who donates at least one pinwheel.

Dedicated Gardens are for businesses or organizations donating a minimum of 20 pinwheels at \$5 each which is a \$100 tax-deductible donation for a small individual garden to be planted at their location. For locations without an area to display the pinwheels, a planter will be provided, so please consider having an organization you belong to consider donating to this project. Some businesses elect to have their pinwheels planted in the community garden in lieu of at their location. Help support the following 8 organizations that have donated so far this year:

We are sending this reminder about the 'Just One Campaign' established by the Mid Atlantic District in July 2023 to encourage growing the membership in your club!

The rewards:

- ➢ When you introduce three members to your existing club each year and they join Exchange, you will receive a reimbursement check of \$16 to cover your District Dues for one year.
- > If you introduce five members to your existing club each year and they join Exchange, you will receive a reimbursement check of \$78 to cover your National Dues for one year.
- Please note the members must be viable active members for the full year to receive the incentive award. New Club builders will not qualify for these awards due to the Club builder rewards already established by National.

Checks will be processed after the end of the fiscal year and sent directly to you from the District Treasurer.
