Kimmy Murray's presentation about spam and other fake emails was very helpful in protecting our cell phones, computers and banking information. She explained some key signs to look for when receiving an unusual email to help prevent you from becoming a victim of internet crime. She suggested that these emails should be deleted without opening them, but then explained what to do after accidentally opening a 'bad' email.
