## **Blue Pinwheel Garden Fundraiser**

Our goal this year is 800 pinwheels, but selling more would be wonderful. The Community Garden will be set up the whole month of April in front of St. John's Episcopal Church and First Presbyterian Church on the Square. For every \$5 donation, a pinwheel is put out in the garden for the month. The money raised will go to Domestic Violence Services of Cumberland and Perry Counties' children's programs. There is a donor page listing the names of the individuals who donate or elect to designate a pinwheel in honor of a child or other person. A separate page will list any business or organization who donates at least one pinwheel. Since our club is a 501c(3), all donations are tax deductible.

Dedicated Gardens are for businesses or organizations donating a minimum of 20 pinwheels at \$5 each which is a \$100 tax-deductible donation for a small individual garden to be planted at their location. For locations without an area to display the pinwheels, a planter will be provided, so please consider having an organization you belong to consider donating to this project. Some businesses elect to have their pinwheels planted in the community garden in lieu of their location. The following businesses have supported our Pinwheel project. # March 11, 2025

At the March 11, 2025 meeting, LTC Damonica Sumpter, United States Army, Army War College Student, gave a presentation about Military Recruitment Challenges. All the branches are working hard filling their slots with people who want to serve their country. A big challenge is that only approximately 23% of the targeted group of men 17 - 24 years old meet the standards to be accepted into the military, and many of those do not have the desire to serve their country in the military. Many others are being drawn to the higher paying technical field civilian jobs. The main reasons why many have not been eligible are obesity, cannot pass the physical fitness test, medical conditions, prescribed specific medication, criminal convictions, illegal drug use, and no high school diploma.
