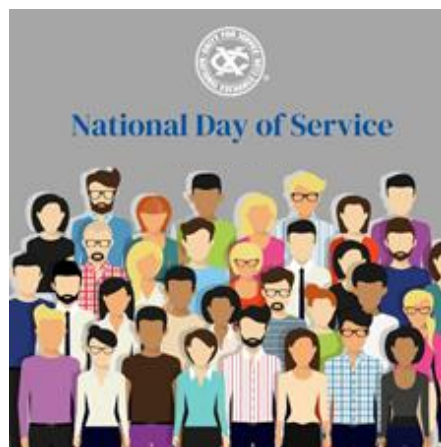

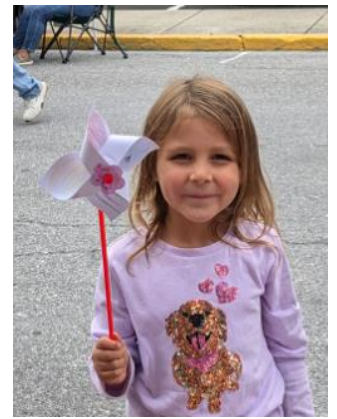


## Day of Service

On September 9, 2024, Dorothy Andrews and Jason Brode gave an educational presentation about the Domestic Violence Services of Cumberland and Perry Counties' AMEND program.
